Debora Hoflock, age 60, of Lake Benton, Minnesota, died at home with family by her side on Wednesday, October 10, 2018. Memorial Services are 2:00 p.m. Saturday, October 13, 2018, at the Hamilton Funeral Home in Marshall. Following a reception, Interment will be in the Canby City Cemetery, Canby, Minnesota. Debora Kay Haas was born on February 6, 1958, in Marshall, Minnesota. She was the only daughter of Carl and Jeannette (Larson) Haas. She was baptized and was confirmed at First Lutheran Church in Marshall, Minnesota. She grew up in Marshall and graduated from Marshall High School class of 1976. She helped on the farm in addition to raising her children and being a devoted homemaker.
